

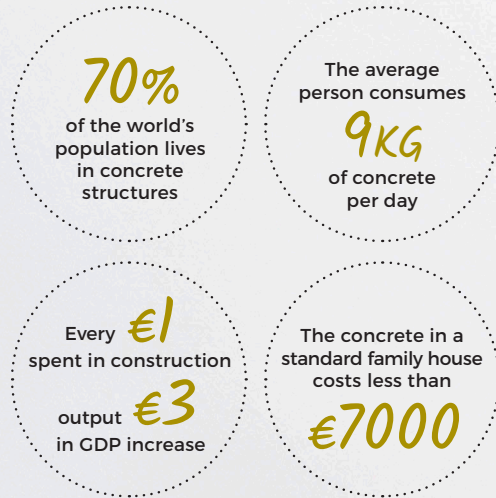


THE CONCRETE RESPONSIBLE SOURCING CERTIFICATION SYSTEM

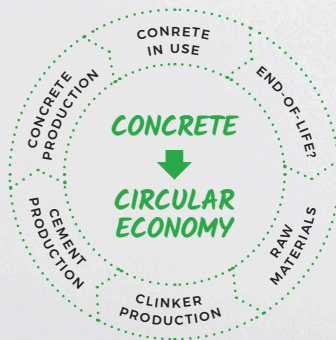
